JOB DESCRIPTION MSD OF WAYNE TOWNSHIP

PURPOSE: To administer the interscholastic athletic programs for seventh and eighth grades.

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Schedules all inter-school athletic contests and sees that proper contracts are on file.
- 2. Hires properly certified officials.
- 3. Assigns personnel to work and supervise at games/meets.
- 4. Manages all aspects of ticket sales.
- 5. Makes necessary contacts to confirm game locations, dates, and times.
- 6. Supervises the coaching personnel and recommends staff.
- 7. Schedules facilities for practice sessions, intramurals, and inter-scholastic sports.
- 8. Confirms athletic eligibility of students.
- 9. Develops and revises athletic handbook.
- 10. Enforces the rules of the I.H.S.A.A., conference, and District.
- 11. Makes purchases in accordance with the recommendations of coaches for individual sports and on the approval of the principal.
- 12. Maintains inventory of equipment.
- 13. Evaluates coaches.
- 14. Maintains accurate financial records.
- 15. Evaluates athletic programs and provides feedback to school administration.
- 16. Keeps the finances of the Athletic Department on a sound business basis.
- 17. Sees that all practice and game areas are in appropriate condition for practices and games.
- 18. Conducts on-going coaches meetings throughout the school year.
- 20. Performs such other tasks and assumes such other responsibilities as the Superintendent or his or her designee may assign.
