PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Coordinates state and district intervention programs in language arts and reading, including the HOSTS program.
- 2. Develops, coordinates, and evaluates kindergarten and early childhood education programs.
- 3. Organizes, manages, and evaluates the Title I program, including the Title I Pre-K program and school programs.
- 4. Manages all Title I related grants and assists in the writing and administration of any additional grants.
- 5. Assists schools in providing professional learning as part of improving student achievement efforts.
- 6. Provides curriculum-related staff professional development and support groups.
- 7. Assists with the school improvement planning process.
- 8. Facilitates and coordinates the work of instructional coaches/staff developers in supporting school improvement processes.
- 9. Supervises the elementary science staff developer.
- 10. Organizes and supervises the textbook adoption process for the language arts areas (K-12), and all content areas K-6 (with the exception of math).
- 11. Performs other tasks and assumes other responsibilities as the Superintendent or his or her designee may assign.
