PURPOSE: Oversees the operation of the in-school suspension (ISS) room.

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Monitors the daily in school suspension (ISS) room including escorting the students to the room in the morning and back to the dean's office in the afternoon.
- 2. Builds a strong academic culture in the ISS room by providing appropriate direction to students.
- 3. Supervises and monitors all behaviors in the ISS room ensuring there is no inappropriate use of technology, sleeping, or other off task behaviors.
- 4. Communicates daily and often with teachers to retrieve school work for the students assigned to ISS.
- 5. Inputs data into the Crosspointe system as assigned by the deans.
- 6. Builds rapport with the students to encourage and develop an environment supportive of appropriate school behaviors.
- 7. Performs such other tasks and assumes such other responsibilities as the Superintendent or his or her designee may assign.
