- 4. Works with teachers to integrate online tools into a blended learning environment.
- 5. Provides standards and best practices for teachers to tie blended learning into lesson design towards a new standard classroom and teaching framework.
- 6. Prepares secondary teachers for virtual education courses through professional development.
- 7. Manages the Wayne Learning Hub (curriculum portal) online environment and encourages its integration.
- 8. In association with the IT Services team, manages transitions to the Wayne Learning Hub.
- 9. Leads content specific staff in curriculum and course development for Achieve Virtual.
- 10. Provides technical support for all virtual options for the multiple pathways to graduation.
- 11. Manages projects and timeframes for all new virtual education initiatives.
- 12. Provides research and data to support instructional direction and goals for virtual and blended education.

- 13. Works with iTEC educators to help develop high quality professional development on blended learning.
- 14. Perform other tasks and assumes other responsibilities as assigned by the Superintendent or his or her designee.
