Performance Responsibilities:

- 1. Reviews student placement and progress with the classroom teacher(s), including both English Learner teacher and General Education teacher.
- 2. Assist in the diagnosis of each student and in the development of an appropriate instructional program.
- 3. Works with individual English Learner or small groups of EL students to acquire and use the English language and reinforces language skills being taught.
- 4. Assists in preparing lessons for each student or small group.
- 5. Maintains a record of progress for each individual student.
- 6. Monitors work activities of English Learners participating in learning in the regular classroom.
- 7. Participates, as requested by the classroom teacher(s), in parent conferences.
- 8. Provides resource materials to classroom teachers to support the instruction of English learners.
- 9. Uses available materials and instructional machines.
- 10. Participates in professional development, as assigned.
- 11. Assists with the evaluation of student progress and preparation of reports as assigned.
- 12. Complies evaluation data and maintains up-to-date files and records on each student.
- 13. Maintains the same high level of ethical behavior and confidentiality of information about students as is expected of the classroom teacher.
- 14. Performs such other tasks and assumes such other responsibilities as the Program Coordinator and/or Chief Academic Officer may assign.
