GUIDANCE COUNSELOR

JOB DESCRIPTION MSD OF WAYNE TOWNSHIP

PURPOSE: To provide services to aid student success in District curriculum and continue onto post-secondary schooling or careers.

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Plans and selects student curriculum programs.
- 2. Administers all standardized tests and surveys and interprets the results to students and parents.
- 3. Plans and coordinates activities such as career days, college visitations, and student and parent orientation sessions.
- 4. Keeps the Director of Guidance informed as to needs of students and recommends changes in the curriculum, programs, and activities as needed.
- 5. Provides counseling to students.
- 6. Interprets the District's objectives to students, parents, and the community at large.
- 7. Maintains student records and protects their confidentiality.
- 8. Provides student information to colleges and potential employers according to provisions of the District's policies on student records.
- 9. Aids students with all of the processes of college application, including application for financial aid where needed.
- 10. Aids students in evaluating their aptitudes and abilities through the interpretation of individual standardized test scores and other pertinent data, and works with students to develop educational and occupational plans.
- 11. Schedules summer school work and homebound tutoring.
- 12. Registers students new to the school and orients them to school procedures and the school's varied opportunities for learning.
- 13. Guides students in their participation in school and community activities.
- 14. Performs such other tasks and assumes such other responsibilities as the Superintendent or his/her designee may assign.
