PURPOSE: To facilitate HOSTS program to meet students' learning needs and provide support for mentors.

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Carries out plans made by the HOSTS Lead Teacher(s).
- 2. Gathers and organizes materials for each child's lesson as planned by the Lead Teacher(s).
- 3. Prepares each child's folder for tutoring session as planned by the Lead Teacher(s).
- 4. Facilitates daily mentoring sessions with mentors and students.
- 5. Catalogues, organizes, and inventories all program books and materials.
- 6. Communicates with classroom teachers and administrators about student progress and goals.
- 7. Communicates with mentors; participates in mentor recruitment and training as available.
- 8. Maintains the tutoring environment through classroom set-up, organization, and coordination with the Lead Teacher.
- 9. Works with students in small groups or individually when there is a shortage of volunteers.
- 10. Helps maintain discipline during tutoring sessions.
- 11. Collaborates with the HOSTS team to accomplish district program goals, including hospitality, communication, recruitment, and training of mentors.
- 12. Performs such other tasks and assumes such other responsibilities as the Superintendent or his or her designee may assign.
