- 4. Continuously appraises and seeks to maintain and improve the efficiency and effectiveness of existing and newly established health services programs.
- 5. Provides professional leadership and assistance in developing objectives and standards of the health services program.
- 6. Acts as a resource to students, families, staff, and the community regarding health services, health education, and a healthy environment.
- 7. Refers students and families to appropriate health care resources to meet their individual needs.
- 8. Performs other duties and assumes other such tasks as assigned by the Superintendent or his or her designee.
