JOB DESCRIPTION MSD OF WAYNE TOWNSHIP

PURPOSE: Develops school health program and administers first aid.

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. When a student presents as ill, routinely checks degree of illness and makes determination concerning a student's need to return to class or to be sent home.
- 2. Administers routine first aid in accordance with established first aid procedures.
- 3. Participates in committee work, i.e., health curriculum committee, AIDS Advisory Committee, and/or wellness committee.
- 4. Conducts school programs of immunization, physical examinations, and sight and hearing testing.
- 5. Trains and advises teachers in accordance with students' individual health plans.
- 6. Maintains up-to-date cumulative health records on all students in building.
- 7. Reports to parents, school personnel, physicians, clinics, and other agencies about student health matters.
- 8. Visits student homes when necessary.
- 9. Assumes authority, in accordance with his or her nursing license, for the care of a student or staff member who has suffered an injury or emergency illness.
- 10. Makes recommendations to administrators and staff on health needs of individual students.
- 11. Implements policy on exclusion and re-admission of students in connection with infectious and contagious diseases.
- 12. Assists school personnel in maintaining sanitary standards in schools.
- 13. Performs such other tasks and assumes such other responsibilities as the Superintendent or his or her designee may assign.
