## JOB DESCRIPTION MSD OF WAYNE TOWNSHIP

PURPOSE: To guide secondary students with disabilities in securing and keeping employment.

## PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Collects, organizes, and analyzes information about individual students to appraise their interests, aptitudes, abilities, and personality characteristics for vocational planning.
- 2. Guides individual students with disabilities to understand and overcome social and emotional problems in the work place.
- 3. Researches and implements training techniques.
- 4. Provides ongoing support, monitoring, and on-the-job training for students.
- 5. Provides pre-employment support including job specific skills and the process for securing employment.
- 6. Teaches communication skills, implementing student behavior and learning programs with the use of behavior modification and crisis intervention.
- 7. Assists with the physical demands of functional life skills and academic skills, in school and community settings.
- 8. Provides transportation in school approved vehicles for students to/from job site.
- 9. Performs such other tasks and assumes such other responsibilities as the Superintendent or his or her designee may assign.
