- 4. Assist teachers in the development and implementation of district curriculum and assessments.
- 5. Share current research and best practice with staff and administrators on an as-needed basis.
- 6. Participate in ongoing professional development and collaboration.
- 7. Keep a log of daily activities to reflect work with students and teachers, as well as other reports as required.
- 8. Perform other tasks and assumes other responsibilities as assigned by Superintendent or his or her designee.
