SUPERVISOR OF TRANSPORTATION

JOB DESCRIPTION MSD OF WAYNE TOWNSHIP

PURPOSE: To develop and administer a transportation program to meet all the requirements of curricular and extra-curricular activities.

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Assigns and revises, as appropriate, bus routes for schools in the District.
- 2. Recruits, supervises, and evaluates all transportation personnel and bus mechanics.
- 3. Oversees transportation employees' professional development programming.
- 4. Maintains transportation vehicular equipment and develops plans for preventive maintenance.
- 5. Authorizes purchases in accordance with budget limitations, District rules, and state laws.
- 6. Maintains safety standards in conformance with state and insurance regulations and develops a program of preventive safety.
- 7. Cooperates with school principals and others responsible for planning special school trips.
- 8. Takes an active role in working with principals in preventing and addressing discipline problems occurring on school buses.
- 9. Develops recommendations for future equipment and personnel needs.
- 10. Acts as liaison with parents for complaints and special requests.
- 11. Ensures Transportation Department conforms to all state laws and regulations regarding school transportation.
- 12. Submits all reports required by state authorities.
- 13. Advises Superintendent on road conditions for potential school closures and delays.
- 14. Performs such other tasks and assumes such other responsibilities as the Superintendent or his or her designee may assign.
