SUPERVISOR OF GROUNDS CREW

JOB DESCRIPTION MSD OF WAYNE TOWNSHIP

PURPOSE: To coordinate, supervise, and participate in the grounds maintenance of the District's schools and facilities.

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Assigns work orders and duties to grounds personnel and inspects completed work.
- 2. Assumes grounds keeping responsibilities.
- 3. Supervises and provides input on evaluations for all grounds crew.
- 4. Confers with school principals and other school personnel when performing maintenance on various school grounds and equipment.
- 5. Trains grounds personnel to perform their duties effectively.
- 6. Prepares schedules and determines the need for mowing, spraying, watering, fertilizing, trimming, and pruning, etc., to maintain turf, shrubs, and trees.
- 7. Procures supplies and equipment as needed to perform duties.
- 8. Provides for snow and ice removal from parking lots, driveways, building entrances, and sidewalks.
- 9. Establishes schedules for the department.
- 10. Maintains equipment in safe and efficient operating condition and makes recommendations for service and preventive maintenance of trucks, tractors and mowers.
- 11. Performs such other tasks and assumes such other responsibilities as the Superintendent or his or her designee may assign.
