## TEACHER OF THE HOMEBOUND PROGRAM

## JOB DESCRIPTION MSD OF WAYNE TOWNSHIP

PURPOSE: To works with members of the special services and school staff to provide for the educational needs and the physical and learning capabilities of homebound students.

## PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Creates, with the advice of the special services staff, an instructional program for each assigned student receiving homebound instruction.
- 2. Meets with each assigned student on a regularly scheduled basis, as determined by the student's homebound plan, for the purpose of providing instruction.
- 3. Takes steps to acquire a good working relationship with the student's parents or guardians, and works to establish with them an understanding and cooperative relationship based on the student's individual needs.
- 4. Writes and files written progress reports on each assigned student.
- 5. Keeps, maintains, and files reports and records as assigned.
- 6. Obtains, through established procedures, appropriate textbooks and other teacher and instructional materials.
- 7. Provide information to District staff on the availability and appropriateness of homebound services.
- 8. Performs such other tasks and assume such other responsibilities as the Superintendent or his or her designee may assign.
