- 3. Plans and participates in parent and family involvement activities, including portfolio parties to share student progress.
- 4. Screens PreK candidates, participates in student selection, and communicates class selection to parents. Makes home visits to welcome students to the program.
- 5. Attends all professional learning, meetings, open houses, and conferences as required to meet the needs of the school and Title I requirements.
- 6. Communicates with school staff to ensure the smooth transition of students into kindergarten.
- 7. Performs other tasks and assumes other responsibilities as the Superintendent or his or her designee may assign.
