- 6. Attends all professional learning, meetings, open houses, and conferences as required to meet the needs of the school and Title I.
- 7. Keeps a log of daily activities to reflect work with students and teachers, as well as other reports as required by Title I.
- 8. Performs such other tasks and assumes such other responsibilities as the Superintendent or his or her designee may assign.
