- 7. Leads content specific staff in curriculum and course development for Achieve Virtual.
- 8. Provides support for all virtual options for the multiple pathways to graduation.
- 9. Manages projects and timeframes for all new virtual education initiatives.
- 10. Provides research and data to support instructional direction and goals for virtual education.
- 11. Works with iTEC educators to help develop high quality professional development with respect to blended learning.
